County, District and Parish Councillors have to comply with a strict Code of Conduct. Councillors will be in breach of the Code if they fail to treat others with respect, bully or intimidate anyone, bring the Council in to disrepute or misuse the Council's resources, to name but a few of the Code's requirements.

Complaints made against District or Parish Councillors are referred to Sedgemoor District Council's Standards Committee. The Committee, and its various panels, are all chaired by non-councillors to ensure that they are impartial and reflect the views of local residents. And, of course, no one is allowed to sit on a panel hearing a complaint against a friend or relative.
