The School cannot facilitate extra Children without putting an even greater burden on the on site facilities

The Design and Access Statement links this application to the next (for 4 permanent Classrooms) therefore it is impossible to give support without reference to the a detailed plan. Problems begin at the traffic lights at the NDR and worsen as traffic moves into Inwood Road and then into Brantwood Road

420 Pupils (future proposal) in a village school is totally unacceptable as it makes St George's similar in number to the biggest town schools in Bridgwater

The school already has more than enough places for children who live in Wembdon Parish . Any extra would almost certainly arrive by car and add considerably to the current problems
