ACTION UPDATE.

Sedgemoor County Council have agreed to put in car counting strips to measure the amount of traffic currently using Wembdon Hill and Wembdon Rise before the works on constructing a roundabout at Sandford Corner commence.

WPC are working with residents to reduce traffic speeds through the Village.

The basketball hoop has been replaced in the playing fields. We are in the process of obtaining quotes for improvement or repair of the playing surfaces in the playground.

WPC are continuing to explore a Neighbourhood Plan for Wembdon. As this will need to be in consultation with Villagers, we have postponed further work on this until 2014.

The first of our Jubilee Oak trees has now been planted and will be protected with a Tree Protection Order. Additional thanks to Dave Agate and John from Monkton Elm. See photo within.




